

Policy 13 - FIRST AID

Introduction

The Glenelg Bowling Club recognises the importance of first aid facilities and a first aid volunteer to address issues that may arise with players, guests and venue hirers.

First Aid Facilities

In order to address the first aid safety issues, the club has:

- A first aid kit in the clubroom which is located in a highly visible and easily accessible location;
- Designated pain relief tables which are kept in a separate lockable location to stop any person with an addiction from taking tablets from the first aid kit;
- A first aid kit and fire extinguisher in the kitchen;
- Volunteers with a first aid certificate (See GBC Policy 24); and
- A defibrillator which is located in a highly visible and easily accessible location.

The club will designate First Aid Officers for each home game where available.

In the case of there not being a designated First Aid Officer on duty for home games, Pennant Side Managers and Umpires are aware that they should call an ambulance in the case of an emergency.
