POLICY 2 - ALCOHOL, DRUGS & SMOKING

Responsible Alcohol Service

The Glenelg Bowling Club understands the importance of responsible serving and enjoyment of alcohol by members, spectators, guests and venue hire patrons.

The club will fulfill its Club Licence responsibilities, in terms of:

- RSA servers behind the bar;
- Appropriate signage;
- No alcohol service to people under the age of 18 years;
- Refusal to serve any patron deemed to be intoxicated;
- Availability of soft drinks, water and snack foods for sale at the bar;
- Maintaining an incident book and implementing enforcement of any infractions; and
- Displaying and implementing its safe journey home policy.

Illegal Drug Issues

The club has a no tolerance policy in regard to a person entering the premises with illegal drugs or a person deemed to be affected by illegal drugs. In such cases a person will be asked to leave or be escorted from the property and questioned about safe journey home arrangements.

The club endorses and abides by the Bowls Australia Improper Use of Drugs and Medicine Policy.

Smoking

Smoking (including e-cigarettes) is prohibited on the club property except in the 2 designated marked areas on the northern side of the property towards High Street. Thus, smoking is not permitted in the clubrooms or on the greens.

The club does not sell cigarettes at the bar.
