

POLICY 7 - CONSTITUTION REVIEW POLICY

Introduction

The Administrative Committee is to establish a Constitution Review Working Party every 3 to 4 years in order to review the Constitution to ensure that it promotes the proposed direction of the Club, enables the use of emerging technologies and meets current legislative requirements.

Once the Administrative Committee has adopted suggested changes, a Special Meeting of the Membership needs to be held for the membership to vote. If a Members vote is upheld, only then can changes be adopted and incorporated into the Club's Constitution.

Review Process

The Administrative Committee has established a Constitutional Review Working Party in order to ensure that the Constitution promotes the proposed direction of the club, meets current legislative requirements, takes into account advice from Bowls SA and the Metropolitan Bowls Association and facilitates the use of emerging technologies.

The recommendations of the Working Party are to be considered by the Administrative Committee and the adopted recommendations are to be voted on by the Full Members who are present at the AGM or a Special General Meeting. Those recommendations approved then form part of the Constitution and need to be registered.
