

SMOKING POLICY

The Glenelg Bowling Club (GBC) is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment and to promoting the health and wellbeing of all its members, volunteers and visitors.

Accordingly, the GBC has developed this Smoking Policy that restricts smoking on its premises.

Smoking is defined as the act of lighting, smoking or carrying a lighted or smouldering cigar, cigarette or pipe of any kind. This includes electronic nicotine delivery systems or electronic smoking devices such as e-cigarettes, e-pipes, e-hookahs and e-cigars.

Smoking inside the GBC Clubhouse is totally banned.

Smoking within the GBC outside grounds is only permitted in one area, that being in the northeast corner of the East Green. This area is appropriately sign posted.

Venue Hire Events that use the bowling greens will be required to adhere to this Policy. This includes Night Owls competitions.

In order to protect the East Bowling Green, Venue Hire Events that do not use the East Bowling Green, will have a temporary smoking area established during that event. This area will be restricted to the outside area near the northwest corner of the Clubhouse and will be appropriately sign posted. This area is considered an appropriate temporary smoking area when no one is using the bowling greens.

Through this Policy, the Club aims to not only prevent non-smokers being exposed to side stream smoke but to also reinforce public health messages regarding the health impacts of tobacco smoke and e-cigarettes (vaping).

All GBC Members should politely ask anyone not adhering to this Policy, to either cease smoking/vaping or to move to the designated smoking area.

Members and volunteers in breach of this procedure will be subject to normal disciplinary procedures. Visitors will be asked to leave the GBC property.
