Wet Weather (Rule 8)

Play must be suspended if rain at the venue interferes with player safety & well-being, or greens are unplayable or are liable to be damaged:

• The umpire may suspend play for a <u>maximum</u> of 1 hour (each occurrence) because of poor weather. If the match does not recommence after 1 hour, play will be abandoned and scored as a draw if the minimum number of ends have not been completed.
